Priority Area #1

Expand service access to and enhance engagement of AANHPI children, youth and families within System of Care communities.

Strategies:

1. Identify and partner with culturally relevant access points
 - Primary care facilities
 - Public health
 - Faith-based communities
 - Schools
2. Schedule calls to share successful models of integrated care between mental health and physical health.
3. Schedule calls to share effective service engagement practices that promote the use of family, faith and friends.
4. Promote linguistic access through linguistically competent policy development, training on how to use interpreters, and training of interpreters in mental health. Share policy language and training resources.
5. Utilize AANHPI webpage to disseminate resources and information on models and promising practices.

Priority Area #2

Build the capacity to effectively serve AANHPI children, youth and families in a culturally and linguistically manner.

Strategies:

1. Provide tools to assess current System of Care capacity to serve AANHPI children, youth and families in a culturally and linguistically manner.
2. Identify capacity building trainings to develop clinical cultural competency.
3. Develop partnerships with local universities and colleges. Create strong linkages between university/college practicum/intern programs and community-based organizations.
4. Schedule calls to share effective service support models and practices that promote the use of family, faith and friends.
5. Utilize AANHPI webpage to disseminate resources and information on models and trainings.
